

Vevay Town Council
Meeting Minutes
November 4, 2025

The Vevay Town Council met in a public meeting on November 4th at 4:30pm. Council members Jeremy Harsin and Lane Penick were present, Keith Smith was absent.

Penick motioned to approve the minutes from October 21st meeting, Harsin seconds motion, all in favor.

Penick motioned to approve claims and payroll as presented, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

The Water & Wastewater rate study was discussed. Notices will be posted at Town Hall and in the Jefferson County Newspaper. The public hearing will be November 18th.

Council received a written request from Terry & Chrissy Elzy for additional stop signs and permanent speed bumps in the VSCF subdivision. Temporary speed bumps will be removed for winter. Council would need to research speed rates, and possibly hiring an engineer. Lane Penick motioned to table the request until further review by our attorney, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

Penick motioned to approve the 2026 meeting dates, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

Mr. Jarrod Iery's son publicly apologized for damages and destroying pumpkins at Ogle Park. He asked if he could return to public parks under adult supervision. Council will have the police dept make that decision.

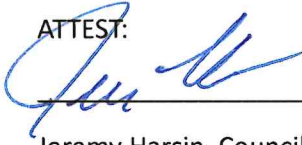
