

Vevay Town Council
Meeting Minutes
December 4, 2025

The Vevay Town Council met in a public meeting on December 4th at 4:30pm. This was a makeup meeting from the originally scheduled meeting on December 2, but did not have enough council members present for a quorum, meeting was canceled. Council members Keith Smith and Jeremy Harsin were present. Lane Penick called in to listen.

Smith motioned to approve the minutes from November 18, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

Smith motioned to approve claims and payroll register, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

Stop signs, speed bumps, and traffic speed limits have been tabled until 2026 for the Danglade/VSCF subdivisions. Smith gave an update that Regional Planning will be installing traffic counters.

Smith motioned to adopt the new water and sewer rates, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

Matt Hocker would like to serve on the Tourism Board for another term. Smith motioned to appoint Matt Hocker for another term, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

Mike Danner has been working on the Historic Fire Bell signs that need re-furbished. Smith motioned to approve artist Kevin Carlson to repaint signs \$2200.00, Harsin seconds, all in favor. The poles need cleaning and repainted, the Fire Dept was supposed to assist with that project in the 2025 budget, will follow up with their time frame.

Smith motioned to renew the Anthem Healthcare policy, Harsin seconds, all in favor.

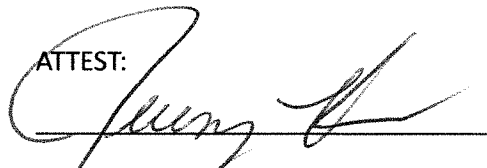

Employee Christmas dinner will be posted for December 19th at 4:30.

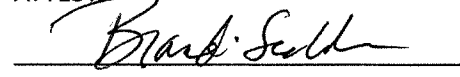
After no further discussion, Smith motioned to adjourn at 4:45pm, Smith seconds, all in favor.
