

Vevay Town Council
Meeting Minutes
March 4, 2025

The Vevay Town Council met in a public meeting at 4:30pm on 3/4/25. All council members were present.

Penick motioned to approve the February 4th minutes Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Penick motioned to approve claims register, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

The shed structure is still within the town right of way at 502 Liberty Street, Harsin proposed civil action to be removed. Penick made the motion to pursue civil action, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Roxanne Morin presented a map for street closures for the Wheels on Fire car show. She will set up 9-10, show will be 12-8pm. Harsin requested policing of beer gardens and traffic control by police or fire dept for assisting pedestrians safely across the highways. Penick motioned to accept car show on May 31st pending special event insurance policy and Emergency Action Plan by the April 1st meeting, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

2024 AFR was presented and signed for council approval. Will be published in Madison Courier.

Two proposals were presented for GIS mapping service. Penick motioned to table until council can review, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Clerk Scudder requested to add Chasity Otter-Barnes to First Financial Bank as second signer for emergency purposes. Penick motioned to accept her as second signer, Smith seconds, all in favor.

Smith motioned to bid all trees out individually, but will still have a total bid line, Penick seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Requests from residents in VSCF subdivision for installing speed bumps back in after winter. Penick also advised to purchase 4 additional speed bumps for middle street with newly built homes.

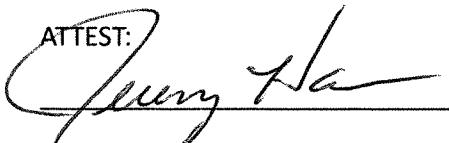
Penick spoke with State to have ditches cleaned along Main St from bowling alley to east end of town limits.

Town Marshal has given 14 violations warning, 1 civil action, 2 moved to unsafe, 4 vehicles have been moved.

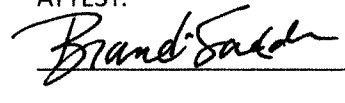
