

Vevay Town Council
Meeting Minutes
April 1, 2025

The Vevay Town Council met in a public meeting on April 1st at 4:30pm. All council members were present.

Penick motioned to approve the minutes from March 4th, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Penick motioned to approve claims and payroll register, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

The shed structure at 502 Liberty Street has been moved.

Wheels on Fire Cruise In has provided the insurance policy (effective May), and will be meeting with Tom Moore for the Emergency Action Plan next week. Council is satisfied with progress at this time.

Smith motioned to table GIS mapping proposals since there is possibility to add users onto SwitzCo Gas plan. Penick seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Christy with River Ridge Realtors asked if the alley will be opened from Greeley to Pearl. Notification will be sent to residents to clear area for vehicle access.

Tree bids were taken as follows: Mullins Tree Service \$9,200.00, Raise the Bar \$11,500.00, Pike Tree Care \$17,400.00, Henderson/Bovard \$28,100.00. Penick motioned to accept Mullins pending insurance approval, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

The next Unsafe Building Hearing is May 6th at 5pm. Complaints have been filed for new ones on Greeley, Pike and Pearl, will have Town Marshal take photos of the properties.

BPA has asked to use Liberty Street for cookout and fundraiser during First Friday April 4th. Penick motioned to grant the use of Liberty, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Scudder worked in conjunction with the County to have Spring Clean-up dumpster days on May 2-4th.

Penick motioned to approve dumpsters, Smith seconds, all in favor 3-0.

Smith motioned to hire a part time or possible full-time officer if budget allows.

Dodge Charger will need to be taken to Dodge for wiring work.

Peters said the fountain liner may be damaged and will need to be hired out.

Jerome Hall with Global Life would like to present supplemental life insurance to employees on April 16th at 10am.

Executive employee meeting will be April 8th at 4:30pm.

Smith stated the SwitzCo Gas board will be closed out June 1st.

After no further discussion, Penick motioned to adjourn at 5pm, Smith seconds, all in favor.
